

WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

This page outlines how the personal data of **www.ghirardi.it** website visitors is handled. This notice is provided in accordance with art. 13 of Italian legislative decree no. 196 of 30th June 2003, also referred to as the **Privacy Code**.

This notice only applies to the Ghirardi website. It does not apply to any other sites accessed via links.

TYPES OF PROCESSED DATA

Browsing data: the IT systems and software procedures used to operate this website collect a certain amount of personal data, which is handled using Internet communication protocols and could lead to identification of the connected user. Such data, however, will only be used for anonymous statistics on the number of website hits.

Data provided voluntarily by the user: data sent voluntarily to e-mail addresses appearing in this website or entered in dedicated forms will be treated in accordance with the principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency, in order to keep the details confidential and protect the data subjects' rights.

PLACE OF DATA TREATMENT

Data handling in connection with website services takes place at the Data Controller's main offices and involves technical personnel designated for the purpose by the Data Controller.

PURPOSE OF THE TREATMENT

Personal data may be used for commercial, promotional and informative purposes, for statistical purposes or to identify potential customers. Personal data submitted voluntarily by data subjects may be communicated to third parties whenever this is necessary for achieving the above aims.

PROCESSING METHOD

Data will be treated in accordance with the provisions of art. 11 of the Italian Civil Code and handled manually using computers and IT tools. Data will be kept in printed or electronic form strictly for the time it is required. Specific security measures are implemented to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorised access.

COMMUNICATION AND DISCLOSURE

Personal data will not be disclosed unless specifically requested by the person involved.

DATA SUBJECTS' RIGHTS

Data subjects have the rights envisaged in art. 7 of the Italian Civil Code, which states that they have the right to erase their details, convert them into an anonymous form or stop details being processed in breach of the law, and oppose the processing of their personal data for legitimate reasons.
